These summative assessments measure student achievement, growth and college and career readiness based on the Iowa Core Standards."

ISASP Short Reading

"Summative Assessment - Any method of evaluation that measures students'

cumulative learning against standard criteria over a set period, typically over the span of the course or school year. State summative test results are used in a variety of ways in different states and districts — as a comparable measure of student performance across schools, districts, and years; as part of state and local accountability systems to measure school performance; as a component of teacher evaluations, and in some cases as a graduation requirement or benchmark measure for students."








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ELA-READING Domain Scores





DEPTH OF KNOWLEDGE (DOK)






Iowa state-level ISASP results




ACSD district-level ISASP results




20–21 ACSD district–level ISASP results: ELA by race/ethnicity








